



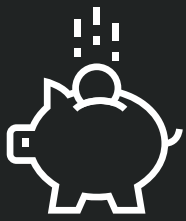

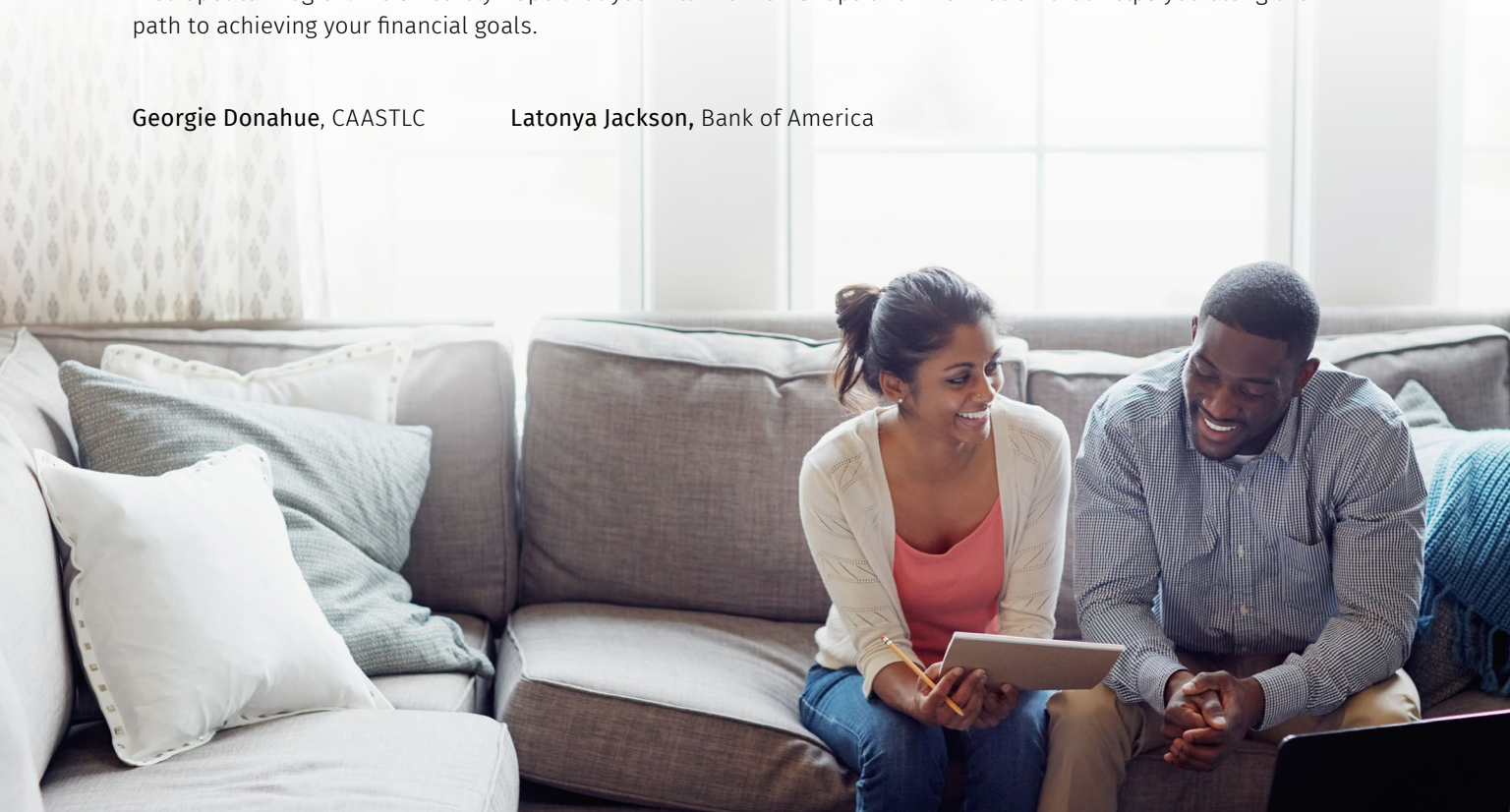
Promoting equitable opportunities for financial health to build wealth and economic prosperity
